

## Te Korako Maori Alumni Travel Award Criteria and General Information

The Te Korako Award is intended to provide financial support to assist a recent Maori graduate who has completed a Masters or PhD thesis to present their research findings at an appropriate local or international conference. This award recognises the value Victoria University places on both Maori post-graduate research and a continuing relationship with its Maori alumni.

### Scholarship Criteria and Information

1. The Te Korako Award recipients will be selected annually by a joint Selection Committee of representatives from Alumni Relations, Development Office and Toihuarewa, after review of application material. Parameters for selection include a commitment to Maori advancement.
2. Awards will only be made to applicants who have completed a Masters by thesis or PhD from Victoria University of Wellington within the previous two years at the time of application.
3. Applicants must submit an application and all required information by the deadline. Recipients will be notified by phone call or letter no later than September 30.
4. Completed application form with all supporting documentation must be postmarked by September 20, 2010 and received within one week. No late applications or parts of the application packet will be accepted.
5. The award is intended to provide support for travel, accommodation and registration at a local or international conference.
6. Applicants must be presenting their research findings from their Masters or PhD at the nominated conference.
7. Applicants will be required to provide proof of conference registration and attendance.
8. Up to \$1000 will be awarded for a local conference and up to \$2500 will be awarded for an international conference.
9. The Selection Committee reserves the right to determine the number (if any) of awards per year.
10. Award recipients must have been enrolled as a New Zealand Maori during the course of their studies at Victoria University.
11. Decisions of the Selection Committee are final in all matters related to the above practices.

- v. The successful applicant may also be required to present their conference paper at a Toihuarewa research symposium in 2010 or 2011.
