4. Does not exceed 2,500 words
5. Is in a print media format (i.e. music and the such cannot be accepted)
6. Essay clearly addresses the conference theme as described on the conference website.

#### Selection Guidelines

1. Selections will be made after 10 May 2005.
2. Applicants must meet all the Guidelines for Consideration (as above).
3. Essays should be accompanied by a short bio note and proof of student status.
